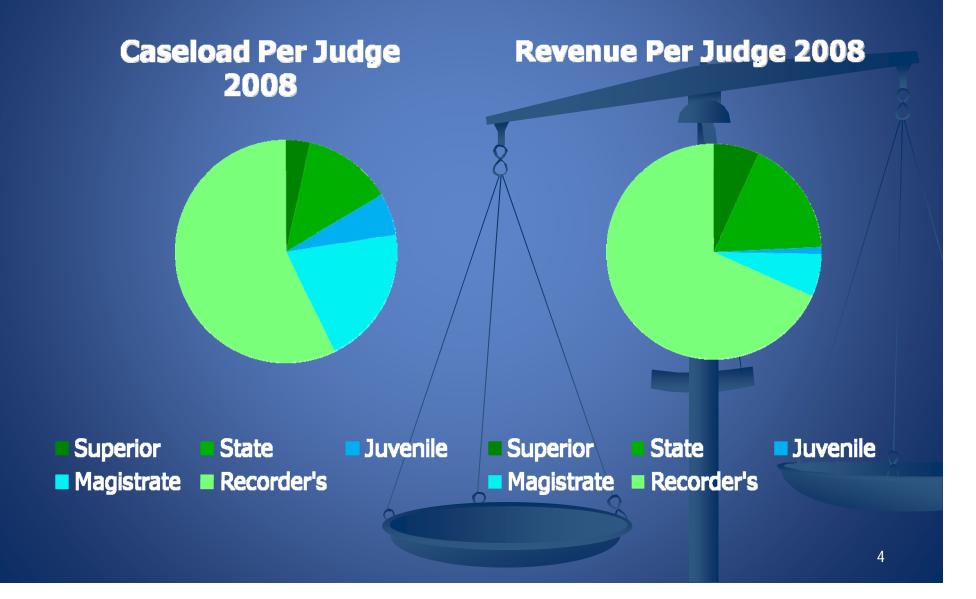

- Staffing
 - Three Judges
 - Support Staff Per Judge
 - Judicial Assistant
 - Manages Judge's Office, including drafting Orders
 - Fulfills a portion of the role of a Court Administrator
 - Calendar Coordinator
 - Is always in Court when Judge is on the bench
 - Completes all Court paperwork for each case
 - Part Time Bailiffs
 - Handle flow of defendants and paperwork in and out of the courtroom

- No Court Administrator
 - Each Judicial Assistant performs a portion of the responsibilities of a Court Administrator
 - Preparation and Management of Budget
 - Personnel Matters
 - Scheduling Interpreters

- 2010 Budget Resources
 - Revenue
 - Increased revenue by charging an Interpreter Fee for defendant's who require language assistance
 - \$20 for arraignment, \$50 for trial
 - \$50,361 collected over 11 months
 - Staffing Levels
 - Decreased Bailiffs from 5 days per week to 4 days
 - Judge's Staff functions as bailiff on Fridays and during Christmas week

- Core Budget Changes 2011 vs. 2010
 - Cut 15% from 2010 request
 - Indigent Defense and Interpreters (now paid from Reserve Account)
 - Remove Tuition Reimbursement
 - Decrease Amounts for Support Operations, Copier Lease, Telecomm Services and General Supplies
 - No Staffing Changes/
 - No full time positions added in 7 years
