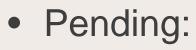

- Present:
 - e-Court: Sustain System Upgrade
 - First major upgrade since 1998 (Justice Edition)
 - Audit: Fund Ledger Balance Reconciliation
 - Unclaimed Cash Bonds (7+ year)
 - \$1.2MK Paid to County (2012 2015)
 - Cash Bond / Garnishment Fund Reconciliation [\$210K]
 - Office Automation (Scanning Current Case Files)
 - Historical Scanning Project (Phase I: \$2.7M, 3 Years)¹

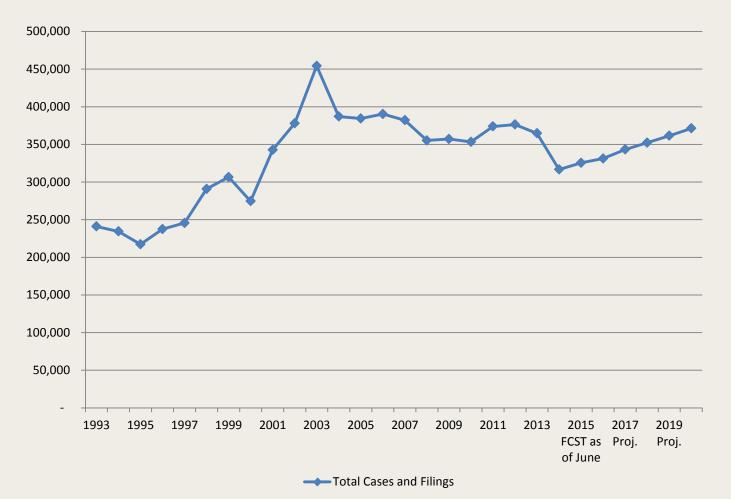

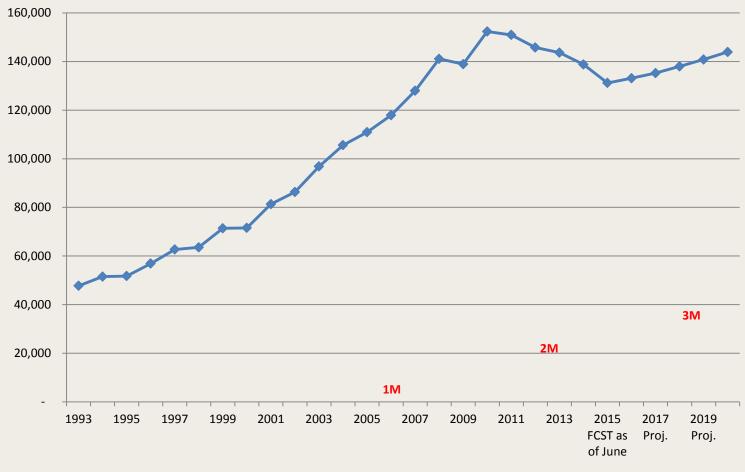

Judicial Case / Deed Filing History

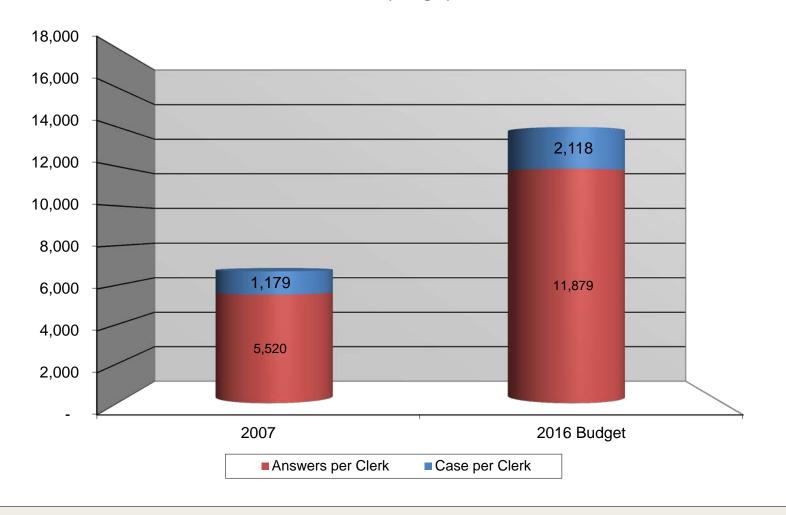

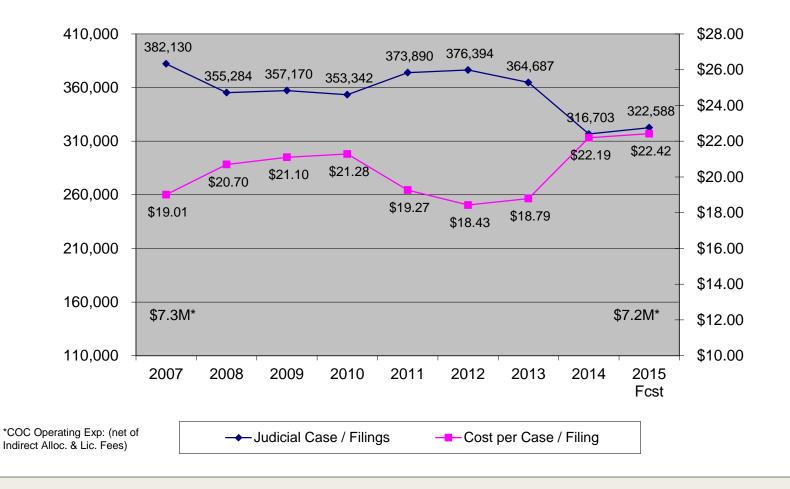

Garnishment Division 2007 vs. 2016 (Budget)

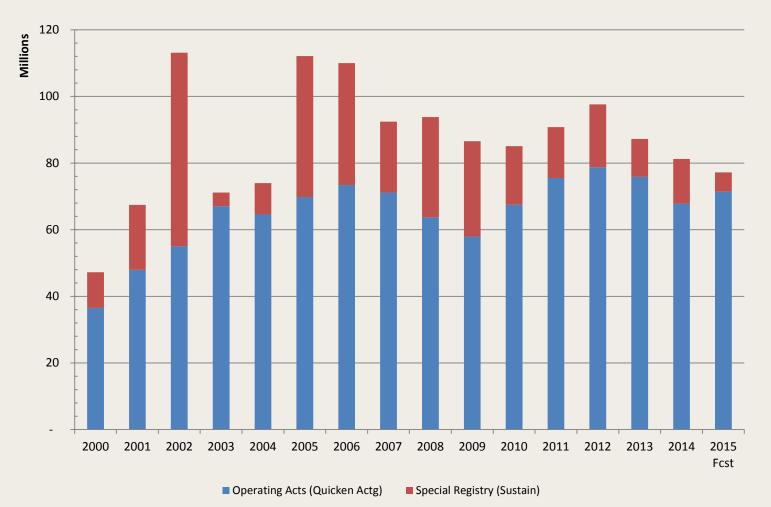


Judicial Case / RE Filings Cost Analysis

Clerk of Court 2016 Budget Summary

- Revenue Budget Projected to Remain Flat at \$16.3M.
- Operating Expense Budget Projected to increase (\$510K).
 - Driven by Indirect Cost Allocations, (\$389K)
 Personal Services (\$137K) GOE 15K.
- Workload (Case Count & Filings) Projected to Remain Flat.
- Objectives and Initiatives Continue to Address the Changing Operating Environment of the Clerk of Court.



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
